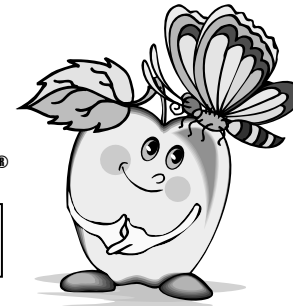




Comparing Apples to Apples

Some dues & fees will be the exact same at every association and so we filled those in for you, however each association does have their own individual dues & fees to consider as well. We have broken the fees and dues by the Designated REALTOR® member type and a description for your reference.
